Is this an orgy?

No way! We do so much more than this, Imagine an art exhibit that is only open to invited guests. We connect over pleasantries; we introduce ourselves and share in a few dances to really connect into all of the listening ways.

What if I'm triggered?

We ensure a few things before hand to ensure that you have agency over what actions you can take. We do have a space open where you can sit to collect yourself and decide if you want to continue.

Sarah, the founder of this group, is a trauma-informed coach and can help you should you seek assistance.

How do you handle inappropriate touching?

We teach each member how to ask fully questions before touching and we expect all members to respect those that are not inviting touch. We also invite members to add their level of comfort to their introduction. An example “My name is Sarah, I am new to this group and today, I am not inviting anyone to touch me.” Or “My name is Sarah, I am very hesitant to touch so please ask before you hug me.” Or “My name is Sarah, I am needing touch tonight, but require you to ask if it is more than a hug.”

What if I want to touch someone?

All touch should be requested “Hello Sarah is it ok if I touch your arm or hug you?” or “Oh Sarah your story was exactly what I needed may I hug you?” or “Oh Sarah, you are just the most inspiration goddess I have ever had the pleasure of hearing. Please, may I dance close with you?”
